### **Employee Killed Maintaining Hydraulics on Forklift**



### What happened?

On March 14, 2008, a 35-year-old equipment mechanic was assigned to repair a leaking hydraulic hose on a powered industrial truck (forklift). The employee was killed when pressure was released on a hydraulic feed line, allowing the truck's hoisting mechanism to lower, trapping and suffocating the employee.

### What can you do to prevent this from happening at your workplace?

- Allow only authorized and trained employees to work on equipment.
- Carefully isolate all energy sources, following written procedures.
- Ensure block, chain or other energy-control steps are taken to prevent movement of elevated equipment parts.
- Release stored energy slowly.
- Verify equipment isolation before starting assigned work.
- Plan and practice emergency procedures.
