

Your L&I payment and remittance advice arrive separately

This information is being mailed with a *remittance advice* that explains in detail a payment from the Department of Labor & Industries (L&I). However, the payment may arrive on a different day because it is printed mailed by the Department of Enterprise Services rather than L&I.

Before phoning L&I about a payment or remittance advice, please wait a few days for the other piece to arrive in the mail.

Matching up a payment with a remittance advice

Your payments arrive with a stub that includes the number of the L&I remittance advice. Don't know

where to look on the stub for this important number? Check out the illustration below.

- 1 L&I Remittance Advice Number (RAN).** This is the number you need to match up a payment and its explanation.
- 2 Warrant number.** A warrant is technically a little different from a check. The warrant number can also help you match up the payment with the remittance advice.
- 3 Your L&I Provider Number.**
- 4 Your NPI number,** if we have one on record.
