It's for small farms that:

- Have less than \$250,000 in annual sales per year.
- Are located in Chelan, Clark, Cowlitz, Grant, Island, Jefferson, King, Kitsap, Kittitas, Lewis, Lincoln, Pierce, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, Spokane, Thurston, Walla Walla, Whatcom, and Yakima counties.
- Have owners who want to teach and mentor interns.

Benefits

- Receive help from up to three interns per year.
- Pass on vital knowledge to a new generation of farmers.
- Interns are exempt from wage requirements and employment security.
- Interns are entitled to industrial insurance while participating in internship.

How do I apply?

- Complete the application: www.Lni.wa.gov/Forms/pdf/F700-158-000.pdf, and include:
 - A copy of an IRS Schedule "F" or similar IRS tax form stating the farm's gross income.
 - An educational curriculum.
