## Section II. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

### D. ALLTRADES: MILITARY VETERAN

In lieu of EDUCATION as stated in Section II.A., and TESTING minimum qualifications, a military veteran will qualify for an oral interview by the JATC to be considered along with other qualified applicants by meeting the following criteria:

The applicant has a minimum of ~~forty-four (44)~~ thirty-six (36) months of active duty and has received an honorable discharge. Meeting this qualification allows the applicant to be interviewed during the normal selection process. This is NOT a form of direct entry. The individual must take the same test required of other applicants (for counseling purposes only).


**9 d. VICE (Veterans in Construction Electrical)**

- (1) VICE applicants must meet all minimum qualifications of the Inside Wireman applicants.
- (2) VICE applicants must have a minimum of ~~forty-four (44)~~ thirty-six (36) months of active duty with an honorable discharge. If the applicant was a member of the Military Reserves or National Guard, additional deployment documentation will be required.
- (3) VICE applicants must apply within seven (7) years from their discharge date.
