Dates applications are accepted:

Applications are accepted on a year around basis.

When to apply:

Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Minimum qualifications:

Applicants shall meet the following minimum qualifications:

Age:	Be at least 18 years of age at time of application.
Education:	Sufficient education to satisfactorily complete the required theoretical instruction.
Physical:	Physically able to perform the work of the trade.
Testing:	N/A
Other:	They shall be working as a roofer/waterproofing helper for a qualified employer. They shall work or show proof of having worked a minimum of 200 hours at the roofing/waterproofing trade.

Applicants are required to:

- (1) Fill out an application for apprenticeship form at 315 W. Mission #24., Spokane, WA., or at the M.G. Wagner office, 1401 Hathaway, Yakima, WA.
- (2) Provide proof of age.
- (3) If the applicant claims credit for any college, military or technical school training they must submit documentation to verify applicant's attendance.

Availability of apprenticeship opportunities:

The number of new apprentices accepted will be based upon the needs of the industry.

Equal opportunity employment policy:
