What does a Residential Glazier do?

The Residential Glazier develops glass handling and cutting skills as well as the preparation and installation of glass in various types of residential windows. Among other craft skills are measuring, cutting and installing custom mirrors, installing estate shower doors and tub enclosures. Residential glaziers will often work on homes where they remove old windows and patio doors and reinstall modern and more efficient windows for customer comfort. Deck Railings, Skylights and Atriums are also another part of this ever growing and popular trade.

A Residential Apprentice is required to complete 6000 hours (3 years). All apprentices are required to have minimum of 144 hours of trade related classroom instruction per year. Classes are currently held during the week.

Safety classes incorporated in the curriculum: Forklift Operator, Scissor & Aerial Lift Operator, Swing Stage Safety, Self Rescue, OSHA 10, Lead, Silica and Asbestos Awareness, First-Aid/CPR-AED, Ladder Safety, Scaffold Safety

APPRENTICESHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- * BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.
- * HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, GED OR EQUIVALANT
- * HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE
- * SHOW PROOF OF AUTO INSURANCE
- * BE PHYSICALLY FIT TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF A GLAZIER

When you meet the above minimum qualifications call our office to make an appointment to fill out an application. You will then be put on the list of "Eligible Applicants" in the order in which you apply.
