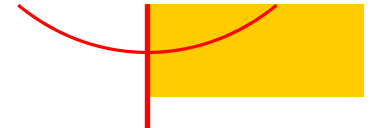

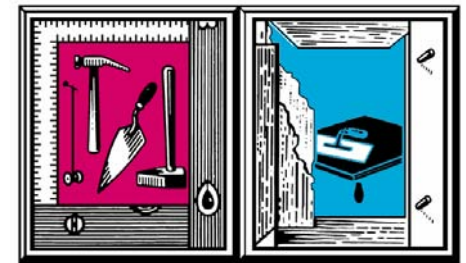

## Wages



Starting pay for Bricklayer, PCC, and Marble Mason apprentices is 50% of journeyman's level. Wages increase every 6 or 12 months with 750 or 1500 hours of on-the-job training. Apprentices must have both to be promoted to the next pay scale.

Starting pay for Tile Setter, Terrazzo Worker, and Finisher apprentices is 50% of journeyman's level. Wages increase every 6 or 12 months with 1000 or 1500 hours of on-the-job training. Apprentices must have both to be promoted to the next pay scale.
