- Barber (SOC# 39-5011.00 - 2000 hours)

STARTING A REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM:

To receive approval as a registered apprenticeship program by the *Washington State Department of Licensing*, and to be recognized as a journey level trainer for the above occupations, potential (plant program) sponsors must submit the following documents for approval:

Cosmetology, Barbering, Manicuring and/or Esthetics Apprentice Salon Shop Data Sheet:

The Department of Licensing will verify that all trainers submitted for approval have been licensed for a minimum of three consecutive years as required in [RCW 18.16.280 \(4\)](#).

Related Supplemental Instruction (RSI) / On-The-Job Training (OJT) hours:

- must be given in a classroom setting under the direction of an instructor licensed in the curriculum for which theory instruction is being provided (for example - a barber instructor can teach barbering theory, but not manicure theory)
