The Department of Labor and Industries will hold a public hearing to receive information and comments for proposed changes to the Electrical Rules in Chapter 296-46B WAC, Electrical Safety Standards, Administration, and Installation.

The proposed changes will increase fees by the fiscal-growth factor of 4.32% for fiscal year 2017 (within the allowable fiscal growth rate established by the Office of Financial Management). The Electrical Program's budget and projected revenue were evaluated and a fee increase is necessary to support the program's operating expenses.
