Subject: Elevator Safety Advisory Committee Appointment

The Elevator Program with the Department of Labor & Industries is currently accepting resumes and letters of interest for the representative for registered general contractor position with the Elevator Safety Advisory Committee.

The Committee consists of seven members who shall serve terms of four years. The Director of the department or his designee, with the advice of the Chief Elevator Inspector, shall appoint the Committee members. The Committee members shall serve without per diem or travel expenses.

The purpose of the Elevator Safety Advisory Committee is to advise the department on the adoption of rules that apply to conveyances; methods of enforcing and administering this chapter; and matters of concern to the conveyance industry and to the individual installers, owners and users of conveyances.

The Committee meets on the third Tuesday of February, May, August, and November of each year, and at other times at the discretion of the Chief Elevator Inspector.
