


WMSD Claims and Costs

Declines in Work-Related Musculoskeletal Disorders (WMSDs)

Washington State Workers' Compensation System 1999–2013

1. Compensable claims include those involving wage replacement for lost work time (4 or more days) or restricted duty, permanent disability, fatality,

- Back WMSDs were most frequent, but decreased the most. Back claims also had the lowest median cost per claim.
- Shoulder WMSDs decreased least, and had a high relative cost per claim.
