Summary of Fatality Data for Washington State in 2005 as of January 12, 2006, as counted by the FACE Program

The Fatality Assessment and Control Evaluation (FACE) Program at the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries collects data on all workplace acute trauma fatalities, regardless of WISHA/OSHA jurisdiction or workers' compensation insurance coverage. The summaries below include all of these data, except where indicated. Who is Included:

All people who were working in the State or in/on the waters off of the State and died due to a work-related incident. This includes workers based in other states, but that have fatal injury incidents in Washington.

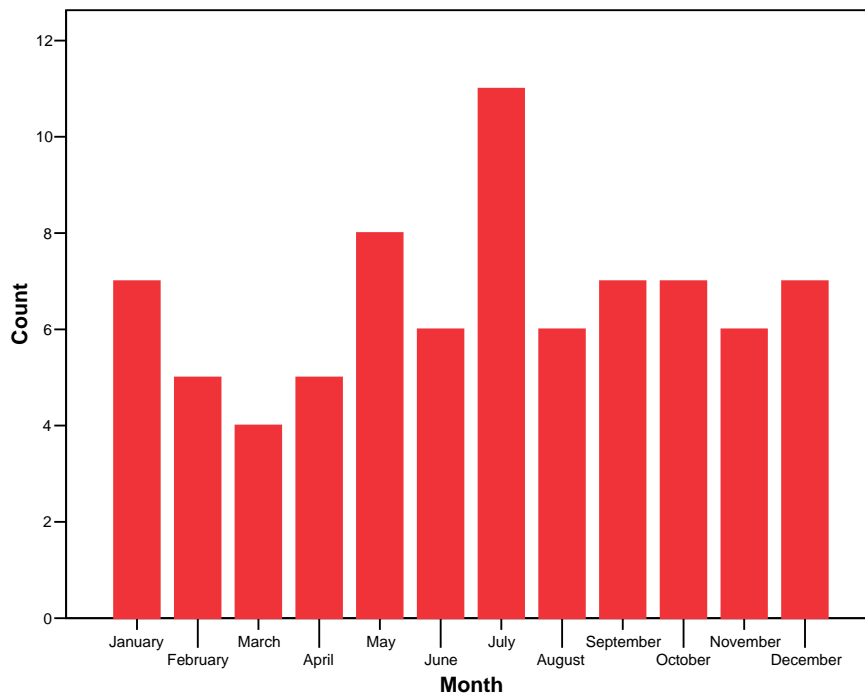
Types of Incidents Included

- Acute trauma fatalities
- Acute chemical exposures
- Suicide
- Motor vehicle incidents

Types of Incidents Not Included

- Naturally caused deaths (heart attacks, aneurysms, etc.) unless there is a work-related component.
- Diseases due to long-term exposure (asbestos and silica)
