#### Local Governments Must Verify Contractor Registration



"No city, town or county shall issue a construction building permit...without verification that such contractor is currently registered as required by law."

Cities, towns, and counties must:

- Print the contractor registration number on the building permit
- Notify the applicant of contractor registration laws and the potential risk of using an unregistered contractor
- Withdraw a building permit obtained using falsified information

RCW 18.27.110

### **Construction Inspections**

- Pre-construction meetings
- Defined stages for required inspections
- Multiple professionals involved at different stages
- Frequent communication is
  key
- Certificate of occupancy is final step
