Remember these tips for safe driving during snowy conditions:

- Leave plenty of room.
- Keep your speed low.
- Have your headlights on low beam.
- Stay in the lane that has been cleared most recently.
- Avoid abrupt actions. Steer and brake gently.
- Consider if passing is really necessary and the effect it may have on other motorists.
