Note: CEU's are required for Electricians, Electrical Administrators, and Master Electricians. If you have not completed the CEU requirements, to avoid late fees or re-testing, you must pay the renewal fees (see above) and your certificate will be placed in inactive status. It is unlawful for Electricians and Master Electricians to work on the job if their card is inactive or expired.

Note: If not fully renewed by their expiration date, assigned administrator and master electricians are automatically unassigned. To reassign, they must a <u>Change of Assignment for Administrators/Master Electricians</u> form (F503-009-000), along with fee shown on the form.
