The [Washington State Department of Labor & Industries](#) (L&I) will hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments to the Factory Assembled Structures (FAS) rules to increase fees by 5.86% and for housekeeping changes. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment on the proposed amendments.

A fee increase is needed to cover operating expenses for the FAS Program. The fee increase is the maximum the state Office of Financial Management allows for fiscal year 2023.

A housekeeping change is needed to correct a typo for rule clarity.

The proposed changes will affect the following Washington Administrative Code (WAC) rules:

- WAC 296-150C-3000, Commercial coach fees;
- WAC 296-150F-3000, Factory-built housing and commercial structure fees;
- WAC 296-150I-3000, Penalties, fees, and refunds;
- WAC 296-150M-3000, Manufactured/mobile home fees;
- WAC 296-150P-3000, Recreational park trailer fees;
- WAC 296-150T-3000, Factory-built temporary worker housing fees; and
- WAC 296-150V-3000, Conversion vendor units and medical units – Fees.
