Administration—What are the definitions of terms used in this chapter?

"Pool heaters" shall mean a gas, oil, or electric appliance that is used to heat water contained in swimming pools, spas, and hot tubs.

- Pool heaters with energy input equivalent to 399,999 Btu/hr (a) (117.2 kW) or less shall be manufactured and certified to ANSI Z21.56, UL1261, CSA 4.7 or equivalent manufacturing standards, as approved by the chief inspector, and are excluded from the limit and control devices requirements of WAC 296-104-300 through 296-104-303.
- (b) Pool heaters with energy input of 400,000 Btu/hr and above shall be stamped with an ASME Section IV Code symbol. and the requirements of WAC 296-104-300 through 296-**104-303** shall apply.
- (c) Pool heaters open to the atmosphere are excluded.

The definition of "open to the atmosphere" in (c) has presented a lot of confusion for installers and some inspectors. This would give clarification to stakeholders.

Administration—What are the definitions of terms used in this chapter?

"Pool heaters" shall mean a gas, oil, or electric appliance that is used to heat water contained in swimming pools, spas, and hot tubs.

- (a) Pool heaters with energy input equivalent to 399,999 Btu/hr (117.2 kW) or less shall be manufactured and certified to ANSI Z21.56, UL1261, CSA 4.7 or equivalent manufacturing standards, as approved by the chief inspector, and are excluded from the limit and control devices requirements of WAC 296-104-300 through 296-104-303.
- (b) Pool heaters with energy input of 400,000 Btu/hr and above shall be stamped with an ASME Section IV Code symbol, and the requirements of WAC <u>296-104-300</u> through <u>296-104-303</u> shall apply.
- (c) Pool heaters <u>without shut-off valves on the discharge side</u>
 <u>are considered open to the atmosphere, and therefore are</u>
 exempt from inspection requirements. are excluded.
