Corrective Action Plans (CAP) - Updates by Quarter Assigned:

October 2021

- Evco Sound & Electronics Inc. #43- Program assigned a Corrective Action Plan to address their deficient Female and minority apprentice #'s at the October 2021 CRRS meeting. Program did submit the CAP timely. Department reviewed the submitted CAP and determined that it does meet the requirements as listed in the CRRS Findings Letter dated October 28, 2021.
 - o Program's training director and committee are actively reviewing their Recruitment and Outreach activities and connecting with new partners to expand their applicant pools.
 - o Program will be appearing before the CRRS in 2026.

October 2022

- Inland Northwest Masonry Apprenticeship Committee #160- Program submitted a detailed Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS. CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to meet the requirements as listed in the CRRS Findings Letter dated October 28, 2022. This is the second CAP that has been assigned to the program since 2020. Program has committed to fulfilling the CAP as stated to the CRRS at the October 2022 Meeting.
 - At the time of this report, program failed to provide a progress report on their CAP progress/ activities to the department
- Western Washington Masonry Trades Apprenticeship Committee #87- Program has submitted a Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS in the Findings Letter dated October 28, 2022. CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to meet the requirements.
 - Program has made significant progress towards becoming administratively compliant with reporting.
 - o Program committee is actively reviewing their CAP activities and progress.
 - Program continues to actively work with their Apprenticeship Consultant on standards revisions to bring their program into compliance. A revision was submitted for WSATC consideration at the July 2025 meeting following approval by their committee at their March 2025 meeting.

Compliance Specialist Report

July 2023

- Northwest Line Construction Industry JATC- #487- Program has submitted a Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS in the Findings Letter dated August 3, 2023. CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to meet the requirements.
 - Program has increased their Scholarship monies approved for Women and minorities to cover 5 apprentices with up to 15,000 per apprentice
 - Program is actively partnered with Clover Park Tech College to provide VOLTA, an apprenticeship readiness program that targets women and marginalized populations.
 Target for the first training is summer 2025.
 - o Program has hired 2 additional staff to assist with recruitment efforts.
 - Program recently had 4 women graduate from the Prep program and qualify for Assignment, however there is a slowdown in available work assignments with over 60 apprentices currently on the out of work list so registration of the 4 females has been delayed.

October 2023

- Puget Sound Energy Apprenticeship Committee- #83- Program has submitted a Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS in the Findings Letter dated October 30, 2023. CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to meet the requirements.
 - o Program is actively working with their consultant to address the deficiencies identified in the Program managers report.
 - o Program is planning on submitting a revision request to the WSATC to bring their standards into compliance at the October 2025 meeting.
 - o Program is actively updating their RSI plans in partnership with their L&I Apprenticeship Consultant & WSBCTC.
- Washington State Controls Specialist Apprenticeship Committee- Associate Controls Specialist- #2175- Program has submitted a Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS in the Findings Letter dated November 7, 2023. CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to meet the requirements.
 - Program is actively working with their apprenticeship consultant on keeping ARTS reporting up to date and accurate.

It is the Departments recommendation that the Corrective Action Plan assigned to the Washington State Controls Specialist Apprenticeship Committee- Associate Controls Specialist be closed by the CRRS.

CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to need revisions so is currently with sponsor for review.
 - At the time of this report, program failed to provide a progress report on their CAP progress/ activities to the department.
- Weyerhaeuser Longview Lumber Apprenticeship Committee-#1829- Program has failed to submit a Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS in the Findings letter dated October 30, 2023. Department sent multiple official notices to the program giving them 30 days to either submit the CAP as assigned by the CRRS or Appear before the CRRS for further action.
 - At the time of this report, program failed to provide a progress report on their CAP progress/ activities to the department.

April 2024

- **Electrical Management Group of Washington-#2214-** Program has submitted a Corrective Action Plan as required by the CRRS in the Findings Letter dated April 25, 2024. CAP was reviewed by the Department and found to meet the requirements.
 - Program is actively working with their apprenticeship consultant on getting ARTS reporting up to date and accurate, this includes extensive records review and corrections.
 - Program is working on developing relationships with local community outreach partners and expanding to include more specifically targeted event towards Female and Minority audiences.
