1. Exception: For all work performed on any and all projects involving tear-off, removal, roof maintenance or roof repair work, for all work processes, the apprentice to journey level ratio shall not be more than two (2) apprentices to one (1) journey-level worker. On job sites with a crew of six (6) workers or less, fifty percent (50%) of the assigned apprentices must be at or above Step 3 (70%). This section shall not apply to a recover project that only involves removing of membrane flashings or sheet metal flashings.
