VI. RATIO OF APPRENTICES TO JOURNEY LEVEL WORKERS

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1. In case of layoff due to lack of work, trainees and apprentices will be laid off alternately.
2. The ratio of Journey Level worker to apprentice remains 1 to 1.
3. For newly approved program sponsors wanting to operate under this variance the sponsor will register their first apprentice within 30 days of approval from the WSATC.
4. Beginning July 1, 2024 Apprenticeship Programs/Training agents will have at
5. least a minimum of 1 registered apprentice or 10% of their non-journey (noncertified) level workers registered as apprentices.
6. Beginning July 1, 2025 the percentage will increase from 10% to 25% of their non-journey (non-certified) level workers registered as apprentices.
7. Beginning July 1, 2026 this percentage will increase from 25% to 100% of their non-journey (non-certified) level workers registered as apprentices.
8. Apprentices and Trainees are allowed to work on the same project.
9. This temporary variance approval expires in its entirety on June 30, 2026.
10. None of the above stipulations are an exemption from following any Electrical Certificate requirements found in RCW19.28.161. Any program wishing to apply for the above variance will need to work with their assigned Apprenticeship Consultant to submit their request.
