- 4. Concurrent employment of Apprentices and Trainees shall be allowed per variance stipulations approved by the WSATC on October 19, 2023. June 10th 2024. Variance shall expire on June 30, 2026. Conditions include:
 - In case of layoff due to lack of work, trainees shall be laid off before apprentices.
 - The ratio of Journey Level worker to apprentice remains 1 to 1.
 - The ratio of apprentices to trainees shall be 2-1 (two apprentices to one trainee).
 - Apprentices and Trainees are allowed to work on the same project.
 - Electrical Certificate requirements as listed in RCW 19.28.161 shall apply.

(Variance Approved 1/18/2024, Expires 06/30/2026)

- <u>In case of layoff due to lack of work, trainees and apprentices will be laid off</u> alternately.
- The ratio of Journey Level worker to apprentice remains 1 to 1.
- Apprentices and Trainees are allowed to work on the same project.
