VI. RATIO OF APPRENTICES TO JOURNEY LEVEL WORKERS

4. **Concurrent employment of Apprentices and Trainees shall be allowed per variance stipulations approved by the WSATC on ~~October 19, 2023~~, June 10th 2024. Variance shall expire on June 30, 2026. Conditions include:**

- ~~In case of layoff due to lack of work, trainees shall be laid off before apprentices.~~
- ~~The ratio of Journey Level worker to apprentice remains 1 to 1.~~
- ~~The ratio of apprentices to trainees shall be 2-1 (two apprentices to one trainee).~~
- ~~Apprentices and Trainees are allowed to work on the same project.~~
- ~~Electrical Certificate requirements as listed in RCW 19.28.161 shall apply.~~

~~(Variance Approved 1/18/2024, Expires 06/30/2026)*~~*

- In case of layoff due to lack of work, trainees and apprentices will be laid off alternately.
- The ratio of Journey Level worker to apprentice remains 1 to 1.
- Apprentices and Trainees are allowed to work on the same project.
- This temporary variance approval expires in its entirety on June 30, 2026.
- None of the above stipulations are an exemption from following any Electrical Certificate requirements found in RCW19.28.161
