### VI. RATIO OF APPRENTICES TO JOURNEY LEVEL WORKERS:

E. The ratio must be described in a specific and clear manner, as to the application in terms of job site, work group, department or plant:

For the occupation of Lineman only:

To insure proper supervision, training, safety, and continuity of employment, the ratio of apprentices to journey-level workers shall not exceed one (1) apprentice to three (3) journey-level workers throughout the sponsor's work force. The ratio of apprentices to journey-level worker shall not be more than one (1) apprentice to two (2) journey-level workers on the jobsite or shop for Step 1 and Step 2. Additional apprentices are authorized at a ratio of one (1) apprentice for each additional two (2) journey-level worker(s).

The ratio of apprentices to journey-level worker shall not be more than one (1) apprentice to one (1) journey-level workers on the jobsite or shop for Step 3 through Step 6. An apprentice shall work under the supervision of a journey-level workers as per the bargaining agreement and past practice.

For the occupations Meter Technician and Estimator only:

To insure proper supervision, training, safety, and continuity of employment, the ratio of apprentices to journey-level workers shall not exceed one (1) apprentice to two (2) journey-level workers throughout the sponsor's work force. The ratio of apprentices to journey-level worker shall not be more than one (1) apprentice to the first one (1) journey-level worker on the jobsite or shop. Additional apprentices are authorized at a ratio of one (1) apprentice for each additional two (2) journey-level worker(s). An apprentice shall work under the supervision of a journey-level workers as per the bargaining agreement and past practice.
