Local Apprenticeship Committee Policies

1. **Hours of work – Policies relating to shifts and hours of work applicable to all production and maintenance employees shall be equally applicable to apprentices where appropriate. Apprentices will only work overtime when all other employees in the craft are working, unavailable, or have refused the overtime to work. Ratio of journey-level workers to apprentices will still apply.**
4. **All apprentices registered in this program under the occupation of Industrial Maintenance Electrician shall obtain and maintain an EL07 trainee card within sixty (60) of starting the apprenticeship.**
