VI. RATIO OF APPRENTICES TO JOURNEY LEVEL WORKERS

4. Concurrent employment of Apprentices and Trainees shall be allowed per variance stipulations approved by the WSATC on October 19, 2023. Variance shall expire on June 30, 2026. Conditions include:

- In case of layoff due to lack of work, trainees shall be laid off before apprentices.
- The ratio of Journey Level worker to apprentice remains 1 to 1.
- The ratio of apprentices to trainees shall be 2-1 (two apprentices to one trainee).
- Apprentices and Trainees are allowed to work on the same project.
- Electrical Certificate requirements as listed in RCW 19.28.161 shall apply.
