## Resources to Provide Harassment and Discrimination Training

While sponsors may choose to develop their own training that meets the requirements of the EEO regulations, below is a list of free resources that sponsors may customize and use to provide anti-harassment training. Resources include:

- The <u>Guide to Using the Anti-Harassment Training Program</u> provides instructions on using these materials.
- *In-person*, *facilitator-led training*: Sponsors may use the presentation <u>Unlawful Harassment in Apprenticeship Programs</u> to deliver the training in person and engage trainees in discussion.
- Online self-directed training: Sponsors can share the video <u>Introduction to Unlawful Harassment in Apprenticeship Programs</u> to trainees, and then ask them to take the <u>Check Your Knowledge</u> quiz.

Trainings should also include review of the Complaints Information page on the apprenticeship gov site.
