

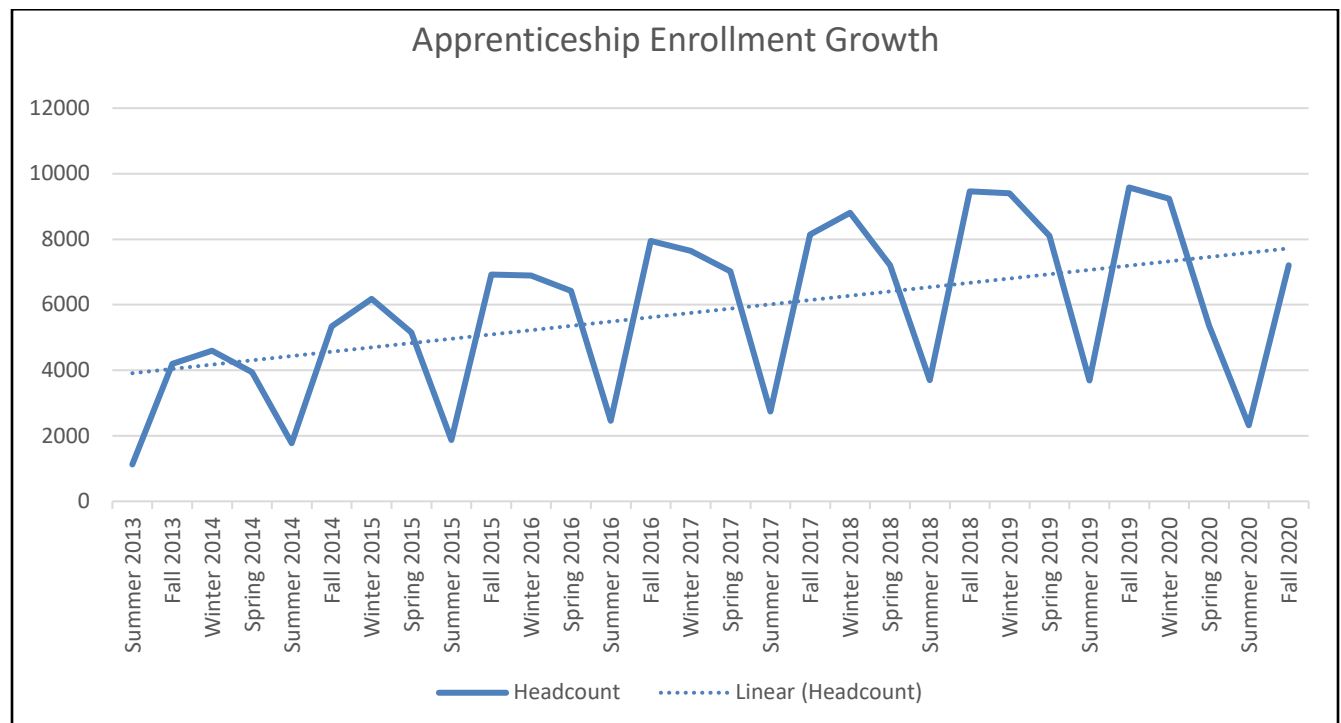
**Report to the Washington State Apprenticeship & Training Council**

**Apprenticeship Enrollments**

There are currently 22 colleges with 179 active apprenticeship programs. During the fall quarter only 16 colleges had actual enrollment in their active programs. The headcount for apprentices in the fall quarter of 2020 was 7,208 (fall of 2019 was 9,579), representing a decrease of 24.75% from 2019. In a comparison of the FTES for fall quarter 2020 to fall quarter 2019, the data shows a decrease of 25.70% in FTES. This marks the fifth quarter that there has not been a growth in apprenticeship enrollments, following twenty-six consecutive quarters of growth. To put the current numbers in perspective, fall enrollment is slightly above our fall enrollment in 2015 (6,920).

### Apprenticeship RSI – Trade Review committee Recommendation

The State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) conducted a Related Supplemental Instruction (RSI) review, lead by the Trade Review Committee on March 25, 2021 (following the rules set forth in WAC 296-05-317). The RSI review included apprenticeship standards with RSI plans for three occupations. A transcript of the meeting communication with attendees participating in the review was provided to the Department as a part of the committee recommendation.

The recommendation to the WSATC for these proposals is:

1. **Approval**, as submitted of the standard from Skamania P.U.D. No. 1 Apprenticeship Committee for:
  - a. Lineman, SOC# 49-9051.00, 6,000 Hours
2. **Approval**, as submitted of the standard from CHAS Health for:
  - a. Dental Assistant, SOC# 31-9091.00, 2,000 Hours
3. **Approval**, as submitted of the standard from Independent Technicians Automotive Committee adding the new occupation:
  - a. Automotive Service Advisor, SOC# 41-2021.00, 2,000 Hours
