
Safety Topic: Wildfire Smoke

- Wildfire smoke can cause eye, nose, and throat irritation
- People with health conditions, older adults, and infants and children are especially sensitive
- Check <u>Wildfire smoke Washington State Department of Ecology</u> for information on air quality
- Avoid physical exertion outdoors
- Avoid driving if possible
- N95 & N100 masks filter fine particles but not hazardous gases and do not work for everyone
- Stay indoors as much as you can
- Keep windows & doors closed
- Air cleaners with HEPA filters, especially HEPA filters with charcoal, can remove or reduce harmful gases from indoors

- > Scheduled and on-demand in-person (IPI) interpretation services throughout the state of Washington and border zip codes that start with 970, 971, 972, 978 in Oregon and 835 or 838 in Idaho.
- Scheduled and on-demand over-the-phone (OPI) and video remote (VRI) interpretation services throughout the state of Washington and any other states within the United States, and OPI services for out-of-country requests.

<u>Services Excluded</u>: Sign language interpretation services and IPI services provided by Language Access Providers (LAPs) working strictly out-of-state and outside the border zip codes that start with 970, 971, 972, 978 in Oregon and 835 or 838 in Idaho.






