SUBJECT: Withdrawal of WSR 19-23-082

The Department of Labor & Industries (L&I) is withdrawing the Preproposal Statement of Inquiry for rulemaking to develop permanent rules for the cranes and derricks industry under Chapter 296-155 WAC, Safety Standards for Construction Work, Part L, Cranes, Rigging, and Personnel Lifting, filed on November 19, 2019 and published under WSR 19-23-082.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) recently updated their standard, thus modifying the original intent of this specific rulemaking effort. Additionally, L&I is filing another Preproposal Statement of Inquiry, CR-101, on July 6, 2021, to consolidate the subject of WSR-19-23-082 and WSR 18-07-091 that will be withdrawn separately for the same reasons above.
