Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The Department of Labor and Industries (L&I) is proposing permanent sections in rule to allow the voluntary use of personal protective equipment (PPE) when workers feel the need to protect themselves from noise, dust, or possible infectious or contagious diseases. The voluntary use of PPE must not introduce hazards to the work environment and any PPE, including facial coverings, must not interfere with an employer's security requirements.

The proposed sections in rule model RCW 49.17.485, Personal protective devices and equipment – Public health emergency, but is not limited to declared public health emergencies. In the event a public health emergency is declared, the proposed sections in rule would already be effective and no material change would be needed to comply with RCW 49.17.485.

Reasons supporting proposal: Allowing workers to voluntarily use appropriate and safe personal protective equipment when it is not otherwise required for the job is essential for the preservation of worker health and safety. During the COVID-19 pandemic, when a mask mandate was not in place, workers in multiple industries continued to wear masks as a means of protection and to reduce transmission of infectious or contagious disease.
