Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The purpose of this rulemaking is to propose amendments to the boiler rules under chapter 296-104 WAC, Board of Boiler Rules – Substantive. The amendments would affect the fees and definitions for boilers and pressure vessels.

Proposed amendments to the chapter are as follows: WAC 296-104-010, Administration - What are the definitions of terms used in this chapter? Modifies the definition of "pool heaters" to clarify that pool heaters without shut-off valves on the discharge side are considered open to the atmosphere and exempt from inspection requirements. o Includes formatting updates by the Office of the Code Reviser. WAC 296-104-700, What are the inspection fees—Examination fees—Certificate fees—Expenses? Increases fees by the fiscal growth factor rate of 6.41 percent for boiler and pressure vessel inspections and other Boiler Program services. Reasons supporting proposal: This rulemaking is needed to ensure the inspection requirements for pool heaters are clear to improve public safety, and that fees will support the Boiler Program's operating expenses. The fee increase of 6.41 percent is the Office of Financial Management's (OFM) maximum allowable fiscal growth factor for fiscal year 2026. According to RCW 70.79.330 and 70.79.350, a fee schedule for inspections is to be set by the Board of Boiler Rules and the fees are to be used to administer the Boiler Program.
