## **Consultation on Oregon Worksites**

## LSI Companies with only Oregon jobs for more than 2-quarters

DOSH Consultation is not able to travel to Oregon to conduct a comprehensive consultation. In cases where an LSI company is exclusively working in Oregon for more than 2 quarters (6 months or more), the following steps should be followed:

- 1. Logging Company must meet all the other requirements of the program (technical premium audit, monthly supplemental reporting, etc).
- 2. DOSH Consultation will do a review of the written APP, review the monthly safety inspections and other safety program requirements as identified.
- Logging Company will contact <u>Oregon OSHA (OR-OSHA) Consultative Services</u> (541-686-7913) and request a Comprehensive Safety Consultation. OR-OSHA Contact: Larry Fipps, Consultation Services Manager.
  - a. Upon completion of the OR-OSHA comprehensive consultation visit the Logging company will request a copy of the entire consultation file. The Logging company will send a copy of the consultation file including their consultation findings to DOSH Consultation services (James Smith, 360-355-5768 or james.smith@lni.wa.gov)
- 4. DOSH Consultation will review OR-OSHA consultation file to determine if the employer is following LSI requirements. DOSH Consultation will either pass or provide corrective actions based on their review of the written program and the OR-OSHA report.
