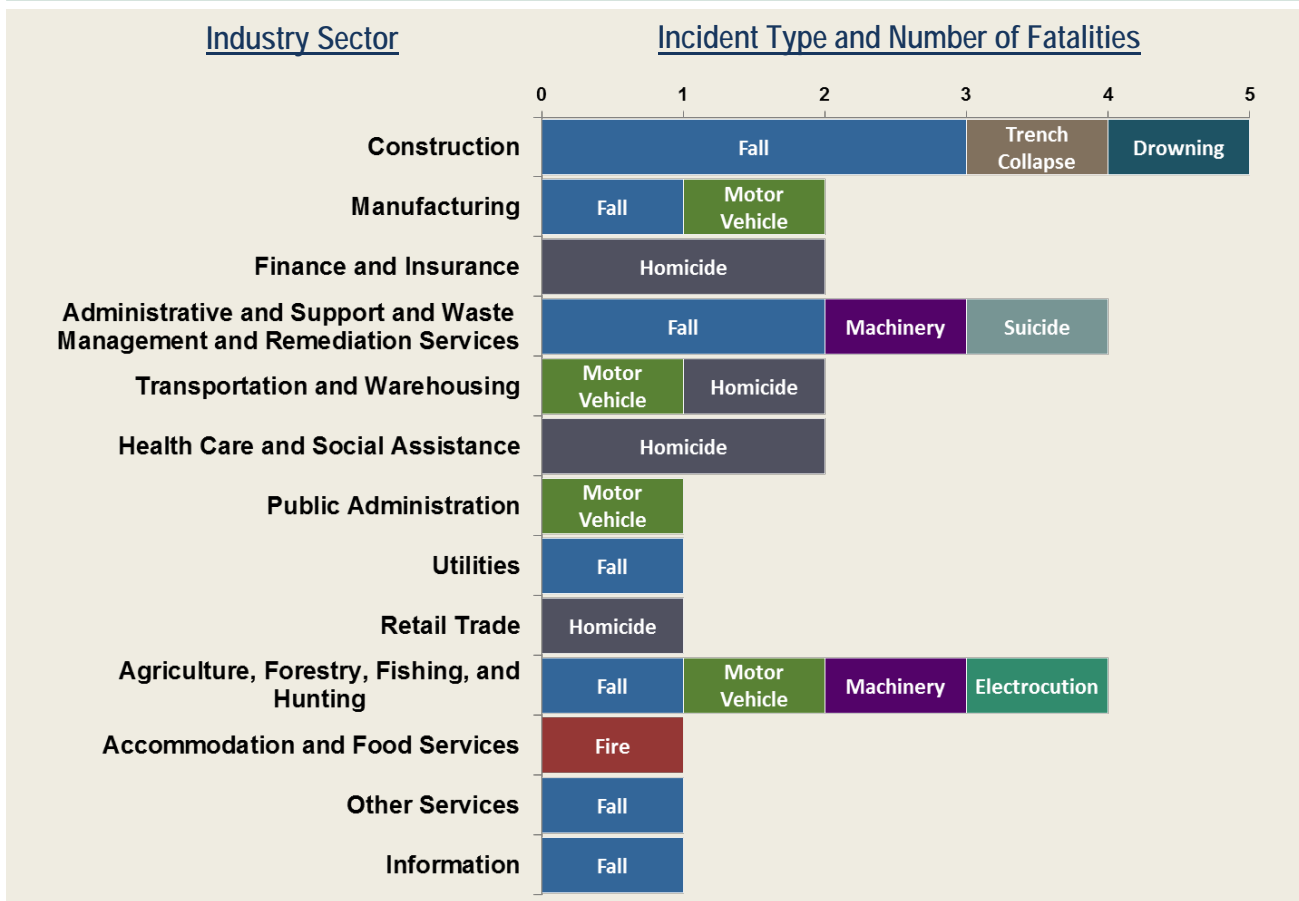


Washington State Work-Related Fatalities: January–June, 2016

Washington Fatality Assessment and Control Evaluation program (WA FACE)¹



- There were 27 work-related deaths in the first half of 2016²

- Over one-third of workplace deaths were due to falls
 - 4 falls were from ladders
- The Construction Industry experienced the highest number of fatalities
- 6 deaths were homicides
 - 4 were gun related
 - 2 were stabbings
