

Future Committee Meeting Process

- Step 1 Two weeks prior to meeting day

- Step 2 Meeting day
 - Meet approximately every 5 weeks for 2 hours or more as needed.
- Step 3 L&I feedback processing
 - L&I evaluates feedback from the meeting and prepares next round of questions.
 - If members have additional feedback after committee meetings, they may send L&I their feedback during this processing step.
- Step 4 Two weeks prior to next meeting
 - Committee members receive work session handouts from L&I. Prepare to share feedback at next meeting.
