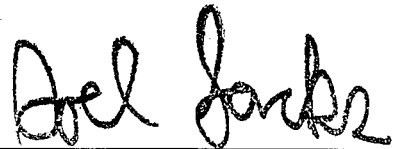

**DIRECTOR'S ORDER DENYING
RECONSIDERATION**

Joel Sacks, Director of the Washington State Department of Labor & Industries, having considered the Department of Labor and Industries' motion for reconsideration, hereby denies the motion. The Appellant contends they missed the prehearing conference due to unclear reasons related to medical issues and a closed office. This contention needs a factual evaluation, which the Director cannot perform. The Director cannot consider evidence not produced at the administrative hearing. *Towle v. Dep't of Fish & Wildlife*, 94 Wn. App. 196, 205, 971 P.2d 591 (1999). The Department has asked to provide briefing on the issue but because the matter needs a factual resolution such briefing would not be useful.

Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement.
